There is light at the end of the tunnel!

By now you will all be aware that in response to the advice from the Chief Health Officer, the Victorian Government has advised that schools can begin a phased return to school.

In the **first stage**, students in **Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2**, will return to school from **Tuesday 26 May 2020**.

To support all school staff to prepare for this transition, **Monday 25 May** will be a **pupil-free day**. This means there will be no online learning on this day. On-site supervision will not be available for those currently attending. Staff will be preparing for the return of students. Watch out for any TheirCare announcements for this date.

In the **second stage** of our return to on-site schooling, all student in **Years 3-6** will return to school on **Tuesday 9 June 2020**.

For those students, in Years 3-6, who have been attending because they cannot be supervised at home, the existing model of on-site schooling will remain in place during the two-week period from Tuesday 26 May to Tuesday 9 June. The current process that we are using to enable parents and carers to indicate the days or part-days for which on-site schooling is required will continue for this two-week period.

All other students learning at home from Years 3-6 level will continue learning from home until Tuesday 9 June.

More details regarding how we will be going about our return-to-school is attached.


