

Dear Parents and Carers,

By now you will be aware that COVID-19 Stage 3 Restrictions are now in place and that the school holidays have been extended by a week. Very trying times, to be sure but the health and safety of all of our community members is paramount.

As a consequence, we will only be providing care and supervision, (not instruction), for those students whose parents/carers cannot work from home and for vulnerable students from Tuesday 14th July.

As you will be aware, from our newsletter at the end of last term and our digital signage, we have a School Council approved, Pupil-Free, Curriculum Day on Monday 13th July and NO STUDENTS will be in attendance on that day.

Please DO NOT send students without first submitting an application (formed attached), which must be approved prior to any student's attendance.

All applications must be made directly to my email please. They should be accompanied by either:

- a statement from your employer indicating your essential worker status; or
- a statement from your employer indicating that you are unable to work from home; or
- a statement outlining your child's/children's vulnerability.

Before/After school care is running but has returned to a paid service but not during the day on Monday 13th July.

With regards to the possibility of returning to remote learning, I will update you all when I have more information from DET. In the meantime, you should have received information in the post regarding our migration to COMPASS, following the shutdown of Flexibuzz. Install the app which is now. We will also post the same information on our Facebook page.
