celebrate!

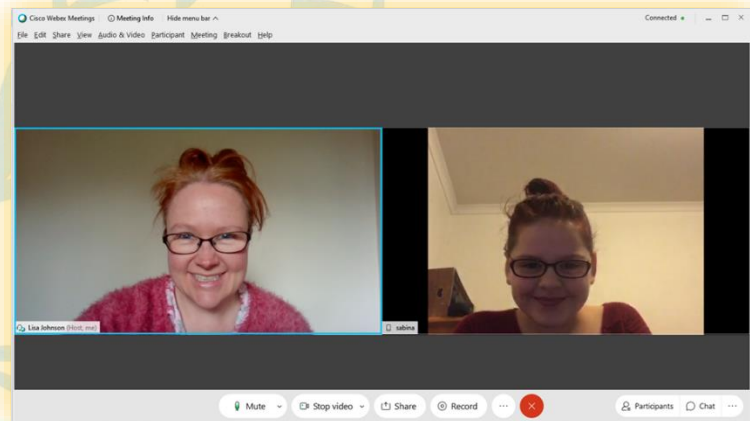
